

The following are highlights from the Winston County Board of Education meeting on July 10, 2006

The Board accepted payrolls and expenditures for June and Financial Statements for May 2006.

The following students and/or personnel were commended:

Board Policy Items:

- Approved termination of Policy GBRGB – Tutoring for Pay by Certified Personnel
- Approved revision of the following policies:
 - GBAA/ DJC-Certified Personnel Contracts
 - DJC/GBAA – Contract Periods for Certified Personnel
 - JBCAE – Admission Policy for Homeless, Migrants, and ELL Students
- Considering revision of the following policy:
 - JDDDB – Saturday School
 - JFED – Promotion, Placement, and Retention
