

Highlights from the Winston County Board of Education meeting on August 29, 2006

The following new policies are being considered:

- GAP – Cell Phone and Electronic Communication Device Usage by Employees
- JCDAG - Cell Phone and Electronic Communication Device Usage for Students
- ECCLAB – Employee Use of Personally Owned Equipment

The Board approved selling a 40' x 140' lot to the Town of Lynn

Revised Salary Schedules were approved.

Bid items that the Board approved are as follows:

- Accepted Coal Bid from Brilliant Coal
- Accepted Propane Bid for a three-year period from Dowdle Gas Company
- Authorized Winston County High School to sell surplus property
