

The following are highlights from the Winston County Board of Education Meeting on August 10, 2006:

The Board approved Payrolls and Expenditures, Bank Reconcilliations, and Financial Statements for July 2006.

The Annual School Budget for FY 2007 was approved.

Dr. Neil Hyche was contracted as outside data collector for PEPE evaluations of principals and central office personnel for the 2006-2007 school year.

Payment to School Superintendents of Alabama (SSA) / American Association of School Administrators (AASA) was approved for membership dues.

Meek Baptist Church was approved to administer the community portion of At-Risk Funds.

The cost per mile charges for use of school bus for extracurricular trips, including athletic and field trips, was changed to \$1.00 per mile, as established by the Alabama State Department of Education for the 2006-2007 school year.
