

The following are highlights from a Special Session of the Winston County Board of Education on August 16, 2007:

- The Board approved contracting with Meek Baptist Church to administer the community portion of At-Risk Funds in the amount of \$26,167.00 for the 2007-2008 school year. Meek Baptist Church will use these funds to pay the salary of the Teacher for Students Overcoming Academic Risk (S.O.A.R.)
- WCTC is authorized to apply for a JAG (Jobs for Alabama's Graduates) Grant through the SDE.
- Approved resolution to petition the State Department of Education and the Office of the Governor of the State of Alabama for a deed of conveyance to effectuate an exchange of property. (See attached resolution)

Personnel Items:

- Approved employment of Jobina Lovett as County-wide School Bus Aide/Substitute Bus Driver effective August 16, 2007.
- Approved transfer of Maranda Farmer from part-time English Teacher and part-time Gifted Teacher to full-time English Teacher at Meek High School for the remainder of the 2007-2008 school year.
- Approved transfer of Leslie Guthrie, teacher at Meek, from part-time Elementary Teacher to part-time Gifted Teacher. Mrs. Guthrie is also employed as part-time Guidance Counselor at Meek Elementary.
- Approved employment of Bethany Powell as Elementary Teacher at Meek Elementary School for the remainder of the 2007-2008 school year.
- Approved employment of B. J. Baker as Teacher Aide at Winston County High School effective August 16, 2007.
- Approved Stacy C. Baker as Jr. Cheerleader Coach at Double Springs Middle School/Winston County High School for the 2007-2008 school year.
