Non-minority students in the fourth grade and older in the 2000-2001 school year and who were identified prior to July 1, 1999, will continue to be reevaluated under the criteria in this exception rule. However, if a qualified team, including the parent, deems it appropriate to use the criteria in the current rule, they may do so, but written justification for this action must be documented in the eligibility report.						
Evaluations required under the exception AAC for Intellectual Disability:						
(a) Vision and hearing screening.						
(b) Adaptive behavior scale.						
(c) Individual educational achievement and/or diagnostic test(s).						
(d) Individual intellectual evaluation.						
(e) Professional judgment should be used to determine if the information, or if other assessment data (e.g., developmental scales, systematic observation) may prove to be a more accurate indicator of the student's level of functioning.

Documentation that the child was provided appropriate instruction in regular education settings
